



**Half Moon Bay Race**  
**Saturday, August 18, 2007**  
**Additional Sailing Instructions**  
**Check-in VHF Radio Channel 69**

**CLASSES**

There will be singlehanded and doublehanded divisions in this race. Each skipper must indicate on the entry form the division and class in which he or she is sailing.

**SKIPPER'S MEETING**

There will be a skippers' meeting on Wednesday, August 15, at 7:30 pm at the Oakland YC.

**TROPHY PRESENTATION**

There will be a trophy presentation and dinner following the race at the Half Moon Bay YC. Skippers are encouraged to anchor or moor off the HMBYC after the race.

**DINNER**

Dinner will be provided by Half Moon Bay YC after the race at an estimated price of \$20 per person. Please indicate on the race entry form the anticipated number of dinners for your party.

**STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS**

The first Warning signal will be at 10:00 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

**STARTING LINE**

A line between the orange marker on the Golden Gate Yacht Club race deck and the "X" buoy off the Golden Gate Yacht Club, leaving "X" to starboard.

**COURSE**

From the Start, to the Finish, leaving both Colorado Reef buoy R "CR" (located approximately 1½ miles W of Pt. Montara) and buoy G "1" (located approximately ½ mile SSW of Pillar Point) to port.

**FINISH**

The finish is at buoy G "3" (approximately ¾ mile SSE of the Pillar Point Harbor entrance), when the buoy bears 000° magnetic. There will be no Committee Boat on station. Skippers are responsible for taking their own finish time and delivering it (on the HMB Finish Sheet, attached) to the Race Committee at the HMBYC by **7:45 pm**. **Skippers who do not submit their completed finish sheet to the Race Committee will be scored DNF.**

**CHECK-IN**

Check-in via **VHF radio channel 69** prior to the initial Warning signal for the race is mandatory.

**REPORTING RETIREMENT**

Any boat that retires from the race or does not finish within the time limit **must** contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via **VHF radio channel 69** or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.

**TIME LIMIT**

The time limit is 6:00 pm on the day of the race.
