



## Corinthian Race - Saturday, May 31, 2008

### Additional Sailing Instructions

*Amended 5/9/08 – Little Harding  
replaces Yellow Bluff*

**VHF Radio Channel 65**

### CLASSES

There will be Singlehanded and Doublehanded divisions in this race. Each skipper must indicate on the entry form the division and class in which he or she is sailing.

### SKIPPER'S MEETING

There will be a skippers' meeting on Wednesday, May 28, at 7:30 pm at Oakland Yacht Club.

### TROPHY PRESENTATION

There will be a trophy presentation on Wednesday, June 11, at 7:30 pm at Oakland YC.

### STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 11:00 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

| C    | Class 5 - Non-Spinnaker   | 11:05      |
| D    | Class 4 - PHRF 161 & over | 11:10      |
| E    | Class 3 - PHRF 100 to 160 | 11:15      |

| G    | Class SPORTBOAT           | 11:25      |
| J    | Class 1 - Multihulls      | 11:30      |

### START

The starting line is between the orange marker on the Corinthian Yacht Club race deck and the orange inflatable race mark immediately off the Corinthian YC, leaving the inflatable mark to port.

### COURSE

From the Start,  
to Little Harding buoy (G "1" FI G 4s) leaving it to port,  
then to Blossom Rock buoy (GR "BR" FI (2+1) G 6s BELL leaving it to starboard,  
then to Crissy Field (Blackaller) buoy (yellow sphere "C" 0.2 nm E of Fort Point) leaving it to starboard,  
then to Southampton Shoal (Iso R 6s 32ft 6M BELL) leaving it to port,  
then to YRA 15 (Y SP "Y" approx. 0.5 nm east of Yellow Bluff) **Little Harding buoy** leaving it to starboard,  
then to the Finish.

### FINISH

The finish line is the same as the starting line, leaving the inflatable mark to starboard.

### CHECK IN

Check-in via **VHF radio channel 65** prior to the initial Warning signal for the race is mandatory.

### REPORTING RETIREMENT

Any boat that retires from the race or does not finish within the time limit **must** contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via **VHF radio channel 65** or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.
