Additional Sailing Instructions

VHF Radio Channel 65

CLASSES

There will be singlehanded and doublehanded divisions in this race. Each skipper must indicate on the entry form the division and class in which he or she is sailing.

SKIPPER'S MEETING AND ENTRY DEADLINE

There will be a skippers' meeting on Wednesday, September 14th, at 7:30 pm at Oakland Yacht Club. This meeting is the deadline for entering the race.

POST-RACE ACTIVITIES

Competitors are invited to anchor in McCovey Cove or to berth at South Beach Harbor after the race and to gather at South Beach YC. Contact the harbormaster's office at 415-495-4911 or VHF channel 9 for berthing arrangements and fees.

TROPHY PRESENTATION

There will be a trophy presentation on Wednesday, September 28th, at 7:30 pm at Oakland YC.

STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 11:00 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

STARTING LINE

A line between a red or orange marker on the Committee Boat and buoy "G" on the Berkeley Circle, leaving the Committee Boat to starboard.

COURSE

From the Start, to the Brothers leaving them to port, then to Little Harding buoy (G "1" FI G 4s) leaving it to port, then to YRA SC1 (Red and Green "SC" FL G (2+1) approx. 1nm ENE of Mission Rock Terminal leaving it to starboard, then to the Finish.

FINISH

The finish line is the entrance to McCovey Cove, between the northeast corner of Pier 48 and the marker FI G 2.5s "1" at the southern entrance to South Beach Harbor.

CHECK IN

Check-in via **VHF radio channel 65**, prior to the initial Warning signal, is mandatory.

REPORTING RETIREMENT

Any boat that retires from the race for any reason or does not finish within the time limit **must** contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via **VHF radio channel 65**, or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.
