## STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 11:00 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

## STARTING LINE

A line between the red marker on the Richmond Yacht Club race platform (on the eastern breakwater) and daymark R " 8 " in the Richmond Channel, leaving the daymark to port.

## COURSE

From the Start, to the Brothers leaving them to port, then to Little Harding buoy (G "1" Fl G 4 sec) leaving it to port, then to the Finish.

## FINISH

The finish line is a line between an orange panel on the Oakland Yacht Club race deck and a temporary mark set in the Oakland Estuary off docks 5 and 6.

## CHECK IN

Check-in via VHF radio channel 69, prior to the initial Warning signal, is mandatory.

## REPORTING RETIREMENT

Any boat that retires from the race for any reason or does not finish within the time limit must contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via VHF radio channel 69, or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.

TIME LIMIT
The time limit is $7: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ on the day of the race.
