# **POST-RACE ACTIVITIES**

No food is served at RYC on Saturday night, but the bar and clubhouse will both be open and available to participants until 7 pm. Bring food to share.

# TROPHY PRESENTATION

There will be a trophy presentation immediately following the Emergency Rudder Race when everyone is settled in.

# **START**

The starting line is between an orange lifejacket hanging on the outside of the RYC Seawall and the Red Day marker directly opposite, in Potrero Reach.

#### **CHECK IN**

Each boat shall check in via VHF radio channel 68 prior to the first Warning signal or whenever the skipper remembers to check in. Sailors will monitor Channel 68 during the entire race. No complaining. No whining.

# SINGLEHANDED SAILING SOCIETY Emergency Rudder Race

#### COURSE

From the Start, to the yellow Bob Klein (BK) buoy, located approximately 200 yards north of the Southampton Platform." BK buoy to be circled either to port or starboard.

## STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 11:55 am. Thereafter, all classes will start at the following intervals, no flags will be used.

# Only the Skipper may deploy the Emergency Rudder.

Emergency Rudder is not to be deployed until participating yacht is in Potrero Reach (e.g. not to be attached or deployed while at the dock).

# EMERGENCY RUDDER EARLY DEPLOYMENT WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE PUBLIC SHAMING AND DISQUALIFICATION.

#### **FINISH**

The finish line is the same as the start, between the orange life jacket on the seawall and the Red Day marker directly opposite, in Potrero Reach.

## RACE DISTANCE

Approx. 3.25 nautical miles

There is no time limit.
